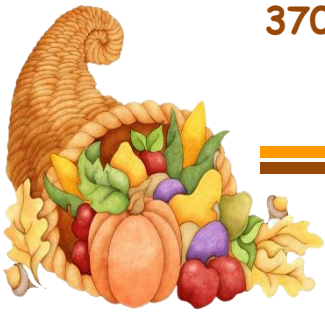

## Announcements and Reminders

### **Request for your COMPLIANCE!!**

Parents, As we approach the colder months, we will see a rise in the incidence of colds, flus and other illnesses. Please be respectful of all children and staff at our school by ensuring you are in compliance with our illness policy.

**Please keep your child at home if they have a fever or flu-like symptoms.**

This is for the benefit of your child as well as other children at the school. We are as diligent as possible in reminding the children to wash their hands after using the restrooms and before eating and ask for your assistance in keeping our Brookside environment as healthy as possible, for the children and the staff, by complying with this request.

It is also our policy that children should not return to school for at least 24 hours after a fever breaks. For any absence more than three days, we will require written clearance from your child's physician prior to returning to school. Again, for the well-being of all other students, please adhere to this policy. Additionally, any communicable illnesses should be reported to the school, so that we may notify other families when something is "going around."

If your child becomes ill while at school, you will be contacted to pick him/her up as soon as possible. It is important that we have a current list of contact people for your child who can be reached in the event of an emergency.

### **LABEL, PLEASE!**

Please remember to label all of your child's outerwear items, as well as their indoor and outdoor shoes! Thank you!

### **PARKING LOT SAFETY**

For the Safety of all our Brookside families, **please follow the arrows on the driveway for entering and exiting the parking lot.** Please leave the spots to the righthand side of the building available for staff members and for persons with a handicapped parking placard. Please use the marked parking spaces in the lot, rather than pulling up in front of the building or behind the staff's cars, as this sometimes causes traffic congestion.

There is a fair amount of activity in our parking lot at drop-off and pick-up times. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ATTENDING PARENT OR CAREGIVER TO HAVE THEIR CHILDREN WITH THEM AND IN THEIR CONTROL DURING THIS TIME.**
